 copy this off a website or other textbook. Use your own words to explain.
- 3-5 example problems solved out, showing each step needed to evaluate, solve, graph, et cetera. Make sure to include special cases and problems of different difficulty.
- 3-5 additional problems left blank for future review before a test/quiz. Make sure
 to include special cases and problems of different difficulty. (Separate answer keys
 to check future work are acceptable.)
